MAG are Demonstrating to our MEPs Against the proposed EU Legislation Article 18 'ANTI-TAMPERING' Regulations



The EU's proposed Article 18 'Anti-Tampering Regulations', restricts our freedom to modify our machines and will have a profound and negative effect on both riders and the motorcycle industry in general.

There is an EU Parliamentary vote on this legislation on Tuesday 3rd July and we need our MEPs to listen to us, as if these regulations are passed they will become UK law. MAG and FEMA (the Federation of European Motorcyclists Association) have been negotiating hard with our own Government and our European representatives in opposition to these proposals.

On Sunday 24th June MAG needs **YOU** to make your voice heard. Each Demo coincides with one of the twelve EU Parliamentary Constituencies across the United Kingdom. Thousands of riders will converge at start points and ride along pre-arranged routes showing the strength of our opposition.

British motorcyclists demand that their elected representatives take notice of our views, so let's show the bureaucrats what we are capable of.

LOCAL MEETING POINT FOR GROUP RIDE TO ROWNHAMS

THE START POINT Rownhams Services (EASTBOUND) Southampton, SO16 8AP. At 1pm the Demo will leave the services on the M27 at J4, travelling East along the M27, then North-East to follow the M3 as far as the M25, where it will disperse.

THE DEMO RIDE This will be a 55 mile Demo with no organised stops, taking approximately one hour at normal motorway speeds. The Demo will **NOT** be a "go-slow", the intention is **NOT** to block motorways. This is a Mass Ride-Out Demo to bring attention to our cause.
